### **What are we Praying For?**

#### **Unity**

**1 Corinthians 1:10**

*I appeal to you, brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgment.*

#### **Unity in Vision**

The Ridge's vision explains why we exist and where we are going.  
Pray that our church is united around our unique and God-given vision.

#### **Unity in Christ**

All believers in Christ are united in Christ.  
Pray that we are united with Christ and with every other believer.

#### **Unity in Doctrine**

Doctrine is teaching imparted by the Word of God.  
Pray that we are united in what we believe and understand as truth.

### **Unity in Relationships**

We were made for God-honoring relationships with other believers.  
Pray that we are united in Christian community with one another.

### **Unity in Service**

We were created to serve God and others with the gospel and the love of Christ.  
Pray that we would be united in serving our community and world

### **Unity in Love**

God is the source of love and first showed us love by sending His Son as sacrifice for sin.  
Pray that we are united in love for Christ and for one another.
